Construct Pattern

Tape Pages (portrait) 1, 2, and 3 together horizontally matching the lines in the corners.

Tape Page 4 (landscape) primarily under the 2nd page. Refer to picture.

Cut

Two pieces for the inside and outside of the wrap following the solid outside line.

Optional: I added a contrasting fabric along the top for added interest.

Cut two pocket pieces for the pocket following the dotted line and going all the way down to the bottom of the wrap on both sides.

One piece of ½ inch Velcro 5 ¾ inches long.

Sew: with ½ inch seam allowance.

Pocket: With right sides together sew along the sides and top.

Clip upper corners. Turn right side out. Press.

Turn the finished sides under and pin to the right side of interior blanket. Follow the parallel lines on the pattern. The finished product should line up with the sides of the pouch. Sew.

With right sides together pin the blanket wrap. Your pocket will be inside of the wrap. Start in an upper corner and sew around the entire blanket stopping at the other upper corner at the top of the wrap. Trim seams. Turn right side out.

Make sure the corners are pushed out, you may use a knitting needle. Press.

Fold the top of the wrap under, press, and top stitch the length of the blanket.


Attach Velcro according to the pattern. The rough side of the Velcro will be sewn on the outside of the wrap. The soft side of the Velcro will be sewn on the inside of the blanket.
